Registration deadline:	All registrations must have reached the IFI office until 06 February 2021 , at the latest, by email to office@icestocksport.com . Registrations must include detailed and binding information about the number of players with whom the member federations will participate. Entries that arrive later than 6 February 2021 will not be considered.
Admission:	4 participants per IFI member nation. Player's licenses must be presented.
Qualification:	Only players who are members of a club that is a member of a national member association of the IFI are qualified to start. (Juniors on 01.10. of the competition year 23 years and younger, but older than 14 years; U 19 on 01.10. of the competition year 19 years and younger; U 16 on 01.10. of the competition year 16 years and younger).
Entry fee:	The entry fee amounts to 15,00 CHF or 14,50 EURO per player and is payable in the course of the registration.



Judgement: The implementing rules for IFI competitions apply – DfB-2020. Judgement is made according to IER und ISpO.

If 9 or more nations participate, 2 groups will be built, A and B, based on the result of the last EC.

Group A: 3 ranked nations, 2 promoted nations, 2 single players who don't belong to the promoted nations = 22 players

Group B: The remaining nations.

Execution: Group B plays team- and single assessment for the B-European Champion with 6 nations, the best 2 nations rise up to the directly following A-European Championship. The 2 best single players from the B-EC (who don't belong to the promoted nations) join in as well. Group A plays for the European Champion with 5 nations and 2 single players = 22 players (team assessment and qualification for the final with 12 participants. After 3 runs the ranks 9 to 12 are eliminated, ranks 1 to 8 play the remaining two runs for the title.

References: The organizer provides the items of sports equipment according to IER 621 to 624 . Foot-mark according to fig. 14 IER.

Doping controls may be conducted to ensure the compliance with the Anti-Doping Regulations.

Liability: Neither the host nor the organizer will resume liability for accidents, other damages or disadvantages of the participants, nor for the composition of the ice- or asphalt surface. With registration or participation the conditions of this announcement are acknowledged completely. A respective declaration must be signed.

Right of the personal picture: With registration for the above competitions, each participant declares his/her agreement, that competition related and/ or personal data (e.g. first – and last name, club membership, achieved results), may be offered to the media (e.g. print media, online-services, TV- und Radio-broadcasters) by the organizer/ host. This declaration includes the publication of competition photos, winner- and team photos as well as videos on online-platforms. A respective declaration must be signed.

CORONA-REFERENCES: Due to the ongoing COVID-19 situations, considerable hygiene concepts are necessary and in exceptional cases short term changes up to cancellation can be necessary!

CORONA MEASURES:

- Each participant must wear a FFP2 mask all the time. The player is allowed to take off the mask for his/her attempt.
