- Admission:** Up to 4 teams per national member federation. Should the number of participants be higher than 22, the number of teams per national federation will be reduced to 3. The organising member federation has an admission for 5, respectively 4 teams. The national federations, except AUT, GER and ITA, are allowed to register players from 2 clubs, where at least 2 players must be a member of each club.
- Only players who are members of a national member association of the IFI are qualified to start.

- Regulations:** International Icestock rules (IER) 2018 and Internationale Spielordnung (ISpO) 2018 in combination with the IFI Implementation rules 08 March 2020 (extract attached for information).
- Note:** In compliance with the IFI anti-doping rules doping controls may be executed.
- Titles awarded:** The winning team will be awarded the title:
„European-Cup-Winner Women's team competition 2021“
- Event leader:** Christian Lindner, IFI President, or representative
- Competition Manager:** Georg Smounig, IFI Vice President for Sport, or representative
- Judges:** Will be announced by IFI.
- Control:** Every piece of sports equipment for the Women's EC must be checked in advance by an A-license judge with protocol. The check of the sports equipment pieces is done according to the DfB-08.03.2020 for IFI competitions. Competition leader and judges will check the sports equipment in advance, during and after the competition. Necessary measures will be taken according to IER and ISpO, resp. VGO of the IFI.
