Dear friends of Icestocksport,

From 22 to 27 February 2022 the 14th Icestocksport World Championships for Women and Men will be held in Klobenstein/Italy. We would like to welcome the best players and teams of your nation for long-distance, target and team competitions in Klobenstein/Ritten. Furthermore a mixed team target competition is scheduled for the day of the finals.

Please note that due to the Corona Crisis IF will not be able in 2022 to cover the same subsidies as in the past years for the participating teams. The national teams must apply for subsidies until **15th December 2021 at the latest** by sending an email to office@icestocksport.com. After checking all applications received the subsidy per nation will be communicated. The check ranges over criteria like the amount of the requested subsidy, necessity of the subsidy for participation, Coronavirus situation, etc.

Special hygienic measures will be taken in the Icerink in Klobenstein due to the Coronavirus situation. The 3G Rules apply. This means that only people who are vaccinated, recovered or tested negative (PCR- or Antigen Test, not older than 24 hours) will have access to the stadium. We will provide the latest hygiene concept 10 days prior to the start of the competition.

**14th Icestocksport World Championships 2022

- Host:** International Federation Icestocksport - IFI

- Venue:** Arena Ritten, Zaberbach 15, I-39054 Klobenstein/Ritten, www.rittenarena.com
- Date:** Tuesday, 22 February 2022 to Sunday, 27 February 2022
- Schedule:** Please find the preliminary schedule enclosed. **The final schedule will be published in January 2022. If further adjustments should be necessary, they will be announced by the competition bureau in the Ritten Arena.**
- Competitions:** Long-distance competition for Women and Men (single and team)
Target competition for Women and men (single and team)
Team competition for Women and men
- Starting right:** Only players with player's license who belong to a club that is a member of a national federation of IFI.
- Admission:** Per national federation:
1 team of women and 1 team of men for the team competition
The starting right in the single competition of the WC of women and men is stipulated on the basis of the results of the previous WC as follows:
Rank 1 – 8: 3 participants
Rank 9 – 20: 2 participants
All other national federations 1 participant each.
For the team target and long-distance competition of women and men one team each. 4 participants for the long-distance competition of women and men.
- Entry deadline:** Entries must be sent to the IFI Office no later than 28 December 2021. The entries must contain precise information about the respective competitions and the number of athletes in the single competitions (long distance and target) in which the national federations will take part. **Entries that reach the IFI Office after the 28 December 2021 will not be considered, as per resolution of the congress.**
- Scoring:** International Icestock rules (IER) 2018 and international regulations (ISpO) 2018 in connection with the implementing rules 08 March 2020 of IFI
- Subsidy:** Please note that due to the Corona Crisis IF will not be able in 2022 to cover the same subsidies as in the past years for the participating teams. The national teams must apply for subsidies until 15th December 2021 at the latest by sending an email to office@icestocksport.com. After checking all applications received the subsidy per nation will be communicated. The check ranges over criteria like the amount of the requested subsidy, necessity of the subsidy for participation, Coronavirus situation, etc.



- Entry fee:** Entry fees are:
- Per team (team competition): CHF 150,00 (EUR= 140,00)
 - Per start in the target competition: CHF 25,00 (EUR= 20,00)
 - Per start in the long-distance competition CHF 25,00 (EUR= 20,00)
- to be paid cash when submitting the players' licenses at registration in the competition bureau in the Arena Ritten.
- Event leader:** Christian Lindner, President of the International Federation Icestocksport
- Competition manager:** Georg Smounig, IFI Vice President for Sport, or representative
- Judges:** Will be announced by IFI.
- Anti-Doping:** Doping controls may be executed in compliance with the IFI Anti Doping Regulations.
- Medical Service:** Weißes Kreuz Ritten
- Liability:** The organiser and implementers shall not make any guarantee or accept any liability for any accidents, other damage or disadvantages incurred to participants or for the quality of the ice. Registration or participation means full recognition of these conditions of entry.
- Accommodation:** See page 4 in the attached bulletin.

- Control:** Each piece of sports equipment for the WC must be examined in advance with protocol by a licensed A-Icestock judge, in accordance with the regulations (DfB-08.03.2020) for IFI-competitions. Competition manager and judges examine the equipment before, during and after the competition.
Necessary measures are executed according to IER and ISpO resp. VGO of IFI.
Team: Max. 20 own winter soles (Winterlaufsohlen) per team are allowed for presentation for equipment control. All athletes are allowed to present 2 shafts for examination. Target: Max.pieces of equipment to be presented for examination per athlete: 1 icestock (Stockkörper), 2 shafts and 8 winter soles.
- Soles (Laufsohlen):** Team competition: Own winter soles may be used. Alternatively, max. 12 winter soles per team may be provided by IFI on demand, so further own soles (Laufsohlen) (until the number of 20 is completed) may be used. **If winter soles should be requested from IFI, this must happen during the registration process.**
Target competition: Personal winter soles may be used. If required, soles are provided.
Sole material that was provided by IFI must be returned for examination (cleaned and ordered). If winter soles are not returned, presumption must be that they were manipulated against the rules. In this case decision can be taken according to rule 361 c und 707 a (Disqualification).
- Icestocks:** Team competition: all athletes may only play those icestocks that are drawn to the respective lanes. Those icestocks have a weight of 3,7 kg and remain on the lanes. Target competition: athletes are allowed to use their own icestocks if they were examined and admitted for this purpose by the IFI control unit. If required they can be provided by IFI.
- Medal ceremonies:** According to § 421 ISpO und IFI-DfB.



Right of the personal picture:

Each participant in the event with the entry declares consent that the competition related and personal data are recorded, stored/processed and may be published (including, but not limited to: First name, last name, DoB, Age, Club, results achieved etc.) in Media (e.g. website, Print Media, Online-Services, TV- and Radio-Broadcast) by the Organiser/Host. This consent includes Competition related pictures/images/photos and videos and Team Photos as well as video platform distribution.

Bustransfers:

Please contact one of the long distance bus companies, that go from Munich to Bozen, for the transfer from Munich Airport to the Ritten in time. The organizing committee will pick you up there to bring you to your hotel. Please register for the transfer until 15 January 2022!
