## INVITATION / CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

### 24<sup>th</sup> Open European Championship for Juniors 2019 55<sup>rd</sup> Open European Championship for Youth 2019

*(Team-Games and Target-Competitions)*

- Organised by:** International Federation Icestocksport – IFI –
- Implemented by:** TSV Peiting on behalf of Deutscher Eisstock-Verband e.V.
- Patron:** Michael Asam, mayor of Peiting
- Venue:** Icestadium Peiting  
Alfons-Peter-Straße 4, D-86971 Peiting/Bavaria/Germany
- Dates:** Wednesday 26 February 2019 to Sunday 03 March 2019
- Schedule:** Please refer to the attachment for the provisional schedule. (The final schedule will be made upon receipt of registrations. Eventual changes will be announced in written form.)
- Competitions:** Team game and target competitions for youth (U16 and U19) and for male Juniors (U23); as well as target-individual and target-team competitions for female Juniors (U23)
- Right to enter:** Only active players with a player's pass, belonging to an association which is a member of a national IFI-affiliated federation.  
(Juniors born on 01.10.1995 or later, U 19 born on 01.10.1999 or later, U 16 born on 01.10.2002 or later)
- Entries:** Each national federation may enter the following:
- 1 Team of Juniors (male) and 1 team Youth (each U 19 and U 16)
  - Four participants for each of the Youth and Juniors target competitions
  - One team each for the Youth and Juniors team target competitions
- Entry deadline:** All applications must be received by the IFE office by **28 January 2019**. Applications must contain precise and binding details of the competitions the national federations wish to enter and of the numbers of players in the individual competitions.  
**In accordance with a congress resolution, any applications received at a later date will not be taken into account.**
- Evaluation:** According to the International Icestock rules and IFI's International Competition Rules (10<sup>th</sup> amendment) as well as the IFI's implementation regulations and congress resolutions.

In the team-games (all classes) there will be final games at the same time on regular lanes (as in the preliminary rounds). There will be no possibility for coaching zones.

- Entry fees:** The entry fees are as follows:  
Per Team in the team-game: CHF 100.00 or EUR 95.00  
Per players entry in the target competition: CHF 15.00 or EUR 14.50  
Payment of fees is to be made **in cash** when players' passes are submitted on registration in the competition office in Peiting
- Overall manager:** Manfred Schäfer, President of the IFI, or deputy
- Competition manager:** Karl Rosenberger, Vicepresident for Sport of the IFI, or deputy
- Referees:** Will be provided by the IFI
- N.B.:** Doping controls may be carried out to ensure adherence to doping regulations.
- First aid service:** Bavarian Red Cross
- Liability:** The organiser and implementers shall not make any guarantee or accept any liability for any accidents, other damage or disadvantages incurred to participants or for the quality of the ice surfaces. Registration or participation means full recognition of these conditions of entry.

- IFI resolutions:** Only sports equipment that has already been pre-examined by the national federation should be submitted for examination, so that no objections are raised. Please use the sports equipment examination protocol, also to be found attached, which is to be submitted in accordance with the implementation regulations at the final examination in Peiting.
- Provision of stocks:** In the team game, all players may play only with the stock bodies allocated at random. These weigh 3.7 kg and they shall remain on the lanes. In the case of the target competition your own stocks may be used if they have been examined and approved by the IFI's sports equipment examination site for the purpose.

**Examination of the sports equipment:** The sports equipment shall be examined in accordance with implementation regulations for IFI competitions (2018).

Team game: You are allowed to present the sports equipment examination maximum 20 own winter-plates per team. All players are allowed to present 2 handles for examination.

Target competitions: Each player is allowed to present the sports equipment examination: Maximum 1 stock body, 2 handles and 8 winter-plates.

**Sliding plate composition:**

Team game: You are allowed to use your own winter-plates. Alternatively you may ask IFI to lend you maximum 12 winter-plates per team. Until there are maximum 20 winter-plates available you may use further own plates. **If you wish that IFI shall lend you some winter-plates, you have to tell that with your official registration.**

Target competitions: You are allowed to use your own winter-plates. Alternatively you may ask IFI to lend you winter-plates.

**Sliding plates distributed by the IFI must be returned to the control in a clean and tidy fashion.** If winter sliding plates are not returned, the assumption has to be made that they were tampered with contrary to the rules. In such a case a decision may be made for disqualification in accordance with regulations 460 c and 807a (disqualification).

**Prize-giving ceremony:** The prize-giving ceremony shall be carried out in accordance with Section 421 of the International Competition Rules and the implementation regulations 2018.

Activities for advertising during the Ceremony are not allowed.

**Implementation:** The implementation of the championships and division into groups shall also take place in accordance with the implementation regulations 2018.

**Photo/Video Release:** Registration and attendance of the Championships implies consent to be photographed/video recorded and permission for photos/videos to be used in future by IFI and/or its members

**Bustranfers:** **There is the possibility to ask for bus-transfers from the airport Munic or from the airport Memmingen to Peiting and back. If you want to use please ask in time (latest at 28 January 2019)**

We wish all participants in the 2019 Championships to be held in Peiting/Germany good luck and a safe journey, a pleasant stay and every sporting success.
