Announcement of the 42th Open EUROPEAN-CUP 2021 in Long Distance Competitions of the IFI

- Host:** International Federation Icestocksport (IFI)
- Organiser:** Niederösterreichischer Eisstockverband supported by ESV Union Winklarn on behalf of the Bund Österreichischer Eis- und Stocksportler (BÖE)
- Patron:** Mayor of Winklarn – Ms. Sabine Dorner
- Venue:** Long distance venue of the ESV Union Winklarn – 3300 Winklarn;
Sportplatzstraße 3
A1 – Exit Amstetten West – Winklarn – sports venue
- Surface:** Asphalt
- Date:** Friday, 10th September to Sunday, 12th September 2021
- Admission:** Only players who are members of a national member association of the IFI are qualified to start.
- Admission:** Up to 6 participants per nation and competition. Player's licenses must be presented.
- Competitions:** All participants will start after drawing the first round playing 5 passages for the determination of the participants in the final and optionally for the team valuation.

Team valuation: If 4 or more teams composed of or 3 athletes minimum participate. The sum of the respectively farthest attempt of the 3 best ranked players per nation will decide about the rankings within the team valuation.

Individual valuation: Respectively the 3 best ranked players of each national federation from the preliminary round will start in the final round including 5 passages. If only 3 or less national federations compete the 4 best ranked players from the preliminary round will move on to the final round. The ranking of the players behind the final round participants will be calculated as per the results in



the preliminary round. If the execution of the final round is made impossible the results from the preliminary round will also be taken into consideration for the final ranking of the individual valuation.

Titles awarded: The respectively best team of a federation composed of 3 players will be awarded the title of an:
„European-Cup-Winner, Team valuation of the Distance competition 2021“
The best individual player will be awarded the title:
„European-Cup-Winner on Distance competition 2021“

Entry fee: The starting fee will be CHF 20.00 (= EURO 20.00) per player to be paid at the time of the entry to the account of the NÖEV (Bank: Sparkasse der Stadt Amstetten, IBAN: AT 45 2020 2001 0000 1049 // BIC: SPAMAT21).

Competition Manager: Johann Mulser, IFI Vice President for International Affairs, or representative

Event Leader: Christian Lindner, IFI President or representative

Judge: The judge will be announced by IFI and will check during the full competition the sports equipment and the players licenses. The Organiser will provide the icestock materials and the soles. Players must provide their own sticks approved by IFI themselves.
