*) The Final Rounds and Finals in the team games will be decided in 2 games. If there is an undecided result after the second game, the game continues with an extension. In this case, 1 attempt of the 4 players per team is carried out alternately on the indicated middle target rings (analog IER rule 403). The total sum of the points achieved by all 4 players of a team decide the victory. If there is one more tie, only 1 player (one after the other, freely selected) plays for the victory of the game. IER R302 and 355 are fully applicable.

The selection for the start in the finals has the team placed better from the preliminary round (= lower starting number).
