\*) The Final Rounds and the Finals in the team games will be decided in 2 games. If the teams' scores are equal after the second game, this game goes into extra time. One try is made on the marked central target rings by each of the 4 players in turn (in analogy with Rule 503 of the International Icestocksport Rules). The total number of points achieved by all 4 players of a team decides which is the winning team; when each team has the same score, just one player continues to play (players are freely selectable, with one playing after the other) until the winner has been decided. - Rules 402 and 454 of the International Icestocksport Rules are fully applicable! The team better placed in the preliminary round (i.e. the team with the lower starting number) has the choice of whether to make the opening try in final matches.
